Enrollment Agreement

1. Length of Program: The VOLTA Program is 400 hours in length, and class will typically convene Monday through Thursday, ten (10) hours per day with one (1) hour for lunch.
2. **Enrollment fee of \$150.00 is required for each application.**
3. **Tuition deposit of \$1,700.00 is due six (6) weeks prior to the start of class.**
4. **Full tuition must be paid in full by close of business the Friday before the session convenes.**
5. To be accepted into the program, you must be a high school graduate with official transcripts OR official Adult Diploma, GED or HISET.
6. You must be 18 years of age prior to the first day of course instruction, verified by a valid driver's license.
7. Medical insurance must be provided prior to the first day of course instruction. Accident insurance does not qualify.
8. I have read the VOLTA catalog (available at www.nwlinejatc.com) and agree to the policies, rules and conditions as stated.
9. By signing this agreement, I attest I am physically able to perform the work of the industry, including climbing utility poles and working aloft.
10. VOLTA is a Drug Free organization and by signing this agreement I agree to comply with the Northwest Line JATC / VOLTA drug and alcohol policy, which may include testing. Testing will be administered after the course has begun. A copy of this policy is included in the VOLTA Catalog.
11. **Climbing gear, tools and supplies commonly used in the industry are required for all students at the students' expense.** The approximate cost is \$2,500.00
12. Students agree to comply with the rules and regulations as stipulated by the Oregon Army National Guard Code of Conduct. Expulsion from the Camp Rilea Armed Forces Training Center, where VOLTA is located, will result in expulsion from the course and the property for a minimum of one year.

The student agrees to perform diligently and faithfully the work assigned in the program during the entire course of instruction and in conformity with the policies, standards, and rules of the academy. The instructors and staff of VOLTA agree to make all reasonable efforts to assure proper and diligent performance by the student of all obligations assumed under this enrollment agreement.
